

Spriptural preparation: Understand the text and use the resource books provided by the parish.

Practical preparation: Practice delivering the text aloud, learn pronounciations, and master difficult words.

Immediate preparation: Arrive early, located readings, and check the sound system.

TRAINING

Register in advance with a letter from your Pastor.

Attend a Lector Workshop, which is available for new and experienced lectors.

In house training will be also be provided after Diocesan training.
