“I am the living bread that came down from heaven.”

-John 6, 51.

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

As the Bread of Life discourse continues in the Gospel for this Sunday, we come to the notion of Life. We have understood the bread that comes from heaven and now must contemplate the life which is tied to its reception.

Pope St. Pius X taught thoroughly on the power the Eucharist provides for the Christian life:

God being goodness itself- and goodness, in the language of Scripture, is the same as perfection- the Christian who is united to Jesus Christ in the Holy Eucharist finds in the efficacy of this sacrament all manner of perfection and holiness. From it he draws strength to rise above himself, to seek after eternal joys, and to despise the deceitful goods of the world because they are unable to satisfy his desires. (*Haerent Animo*, 5.)

The development of the understanding of life is an essential Christian principle. Christ shows us that we do not only possess the possibility for grace while we live on earth, with the drudgery and challenges of certain aspects of existence sidelined compared to the blessings of God in mind, body, and spirit but also that eternal life is a possibility. For the people of his time, there was an enlightening way of understanding the very human essence. While we may be used to the phrase “eternal life,” it was one of the most important revelations of the Messiah at the time.

Let us pray before the Eucharist in this time that richness of Christ’s message is strong and living in our hearts and understanding.

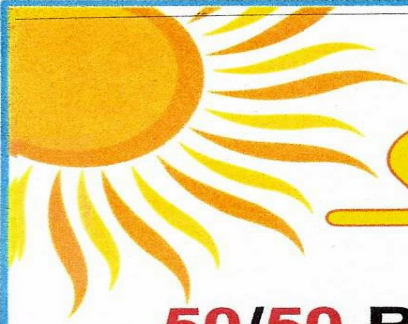

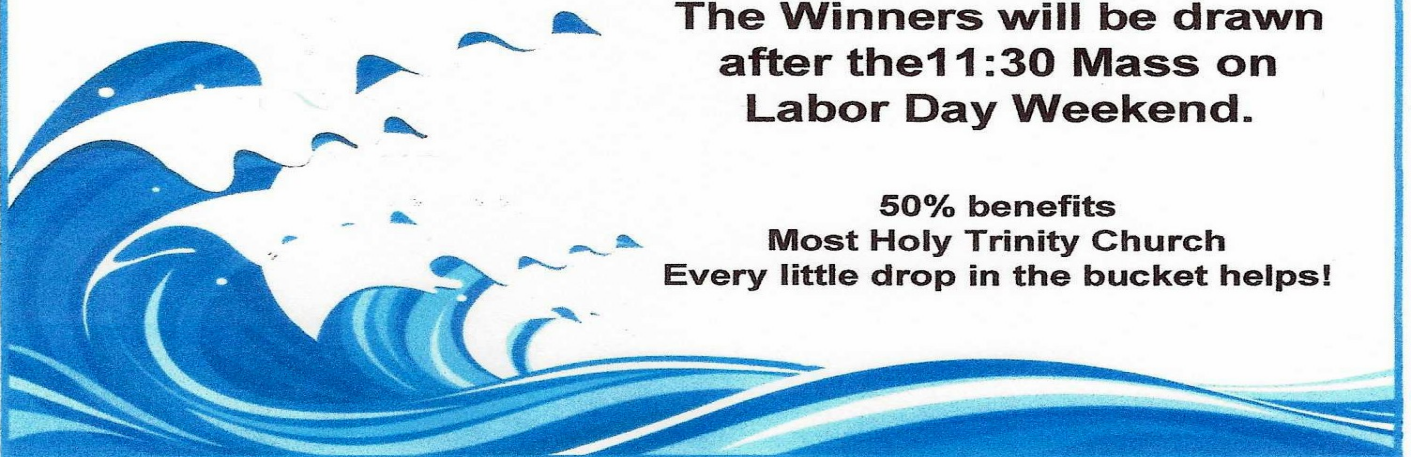
