Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

As the Church progresses this Sunday from our month long mediation on the Bread of Life discourse of Christ in the Sunday readings, we come now to the consideration of how we incorporate the blessings of God’s sacraments into our daily lives. The Eucharist is of course, one of the primary areas of concern. The simple fact is that while we are being strengthened, we can still learn and improve.

St. Bernard of Clarivaux, whose feast the Church celebrated earlier this week mediated well on our close connection with the Lord through our daily prayer:

“Brothers and sisters, the prophets gave us salutary advice: If today we hear God’s voice, let us not harden our hearts. Gospel and prophets here speak almost the same language, for the Lord says: “My sheep hear my voice”; and holy David had said before him: “His people and the sheep he pastures, if today you hear his voice, harden not your hearts.” Listen, finally, to Habakkuk, who does not soften the Lord’s warning but reflects on it: “I shall keep watch and mount the ramparts to see what he says to me and what answer I shall give to his charge.” We too, brothers and sisters, must watch, for now is the time of battle.”

(Sermons on Various Occasions, 5.)

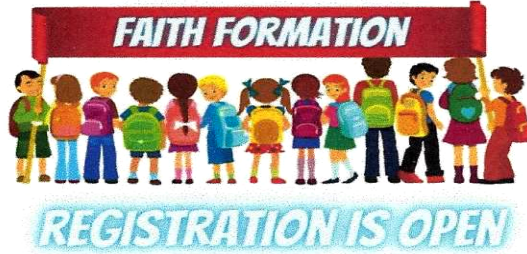

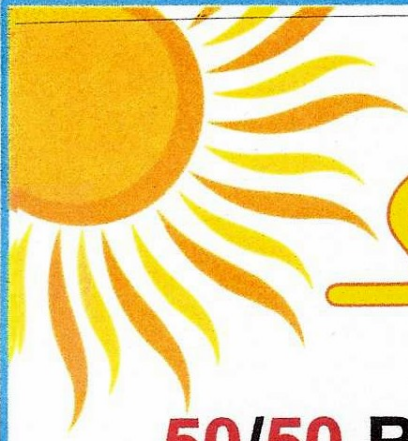

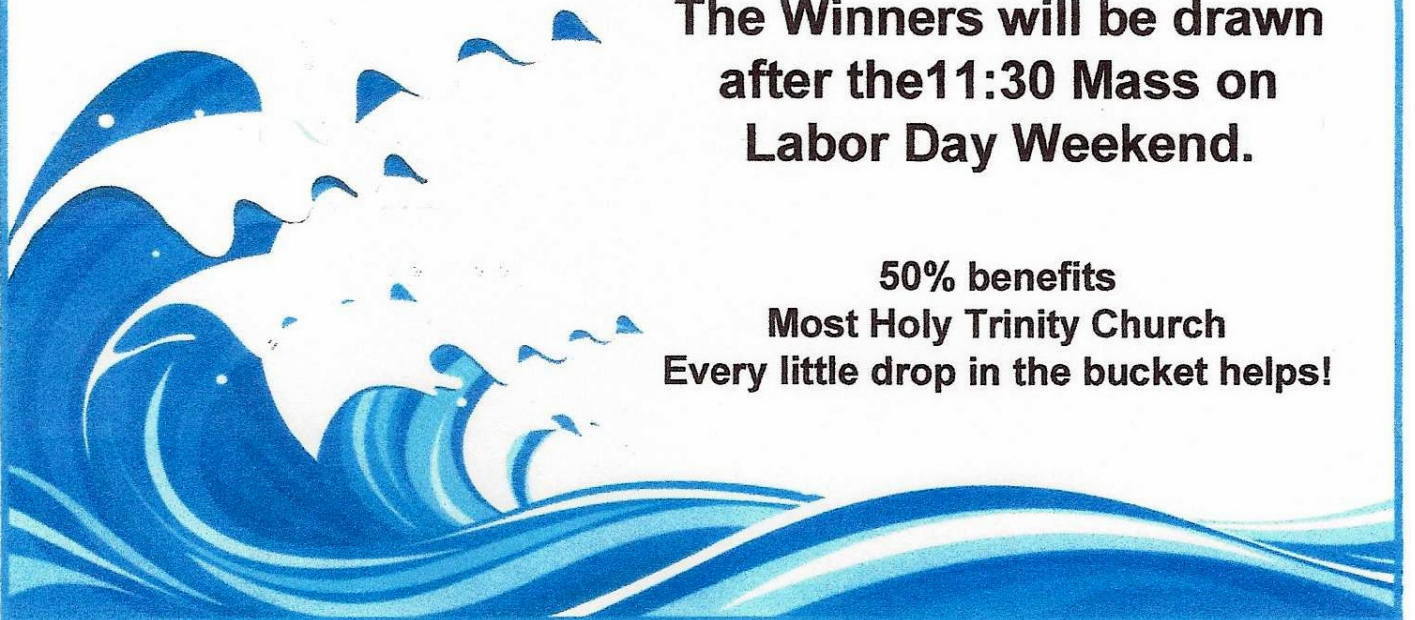
