Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

With the Gospel of this Sunday, we see the beauty of the family enshrined by Christ in all his glory. First, he speaks to the beauty of marriage, both its essential qualities for holy living in our world and its inviolability. He immediately follows in the Gospel with the next logical step: Let the children come to me; do not prevent them, for the kingdom of God belongs to such as these. (Mk. 10,14.)

What the Lord is attempting to express is both his complete understanding of our existence- not only from a divine mentality, which we should expect anyway, but from a human perspective. This is the great blessing of the Incarnation of Christ, that he knows us.

He places familial love at the center. First it is that between husband and wife, then between parents and children. At the same time, the creation of a household founded in love enriches friends and loved ones who can be as close as family. In the model of Christ, sacrificial love is often a part of the daily life of love, as St. John's Gospel reminds us, "In finem delexit eos - He loved them to the end." (John 13,1.)

May the sacrament we enjoy this Sunday guide us forward to love and be at peace, no matter what the cost.
