Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

This weekend, our nation and Christian culture celebrates Mother’s Day, which is an excellent time to consider the provision of God in both care and wisdom. Across the spectrum of these two great gifts, we are called to give thanks to God for the example of mothers who look after their children on a daily basis; this care ranges from the most important social teaching and medical attention to decent senses of humor and moments of levity.

Simply put, the mother has the ability to show the holistic care of the Lord ‘from start to finish.’ Our responsibility this day is to pray well to the Lord for the mothers who guide the children of the church at all moments.

St. Hilary of Poitiers prays well to the maternal nature of the Lord:

O God we look to Your support for the first trembling steps of this undertaking, to Your aid that it may gain strength and prosper. We look to You to give us the fellowship of that Spirit Who guided the Prophets and the Apostles, that we may take their words in the sense in which they spoke and assign its right shade of meaning to every utterance. For we shall speak of things which they preached in a mystery; of You, O God Eternal, Father of the Eternal and Only-begotten God, Who alone art without birth, and of the One Lord Jesus Christ, born of You from everlasting. We may not sever Him from You, or make Him one of a plurality of Gods, on any plea of difference of nature. We may not say that He is not begotten of You, because You are One. (De Trinitate, 1:37-38.)

Let us give thanks to God for our mothers this weekend, in gratitude.

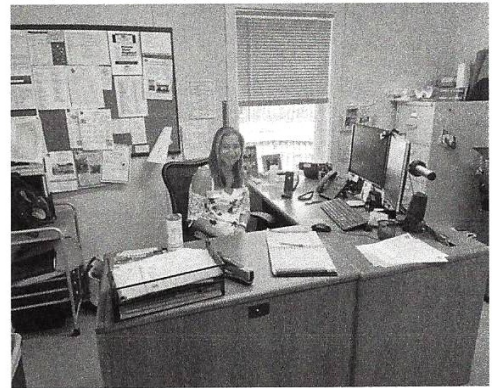

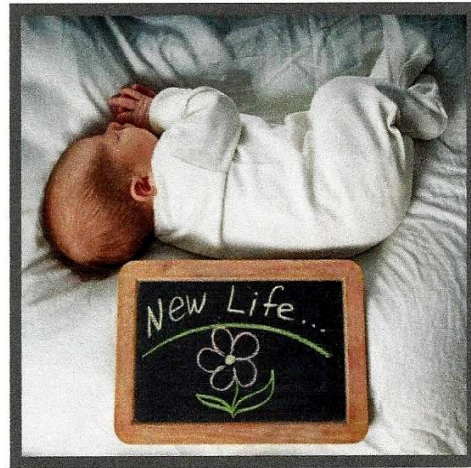
