Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

This Sunday, the development of the Beatitudes by Christ recalls the fact that for the first half of the month of October, the Church revels in the spirit of St. Francis of Assisi, whose feast day on the 4th of October begins our recollection of the life of this great figure in the Church's history and choir of saints. From his Intense spirituality to his deep austerity, he was a figure who changed the accessibility of rank and file believers to the depths of spiritual discernment. One useful meditation comes from a letter sent to his growing order of friars in 1226:

Omnipotent, Eternal, just and merciful God, grant to us that doing for your sake, what we know you want, and always wanting, what pleases you, as ones interiorly cleansed, interiorly illumined and inflamed with the fire of the Holy Spirit, we might follow the footsteps of your Beloved Son, Our Lord Jesus Christ, and attain to you, Most High, by your grace alone, who in perfect Trinity and simple Unity lives and reigns and is glorified as the Omnipotent God, for all the ages of ages. Amen.

Let us embrace his spirit of humility, commitment, and steadfast faith.

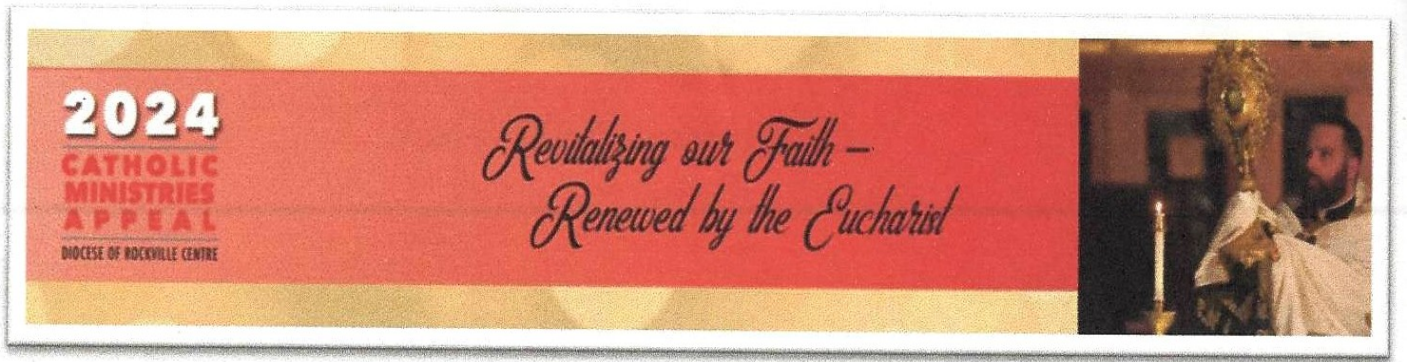
Secretary of Faith Formation
